Resolution No. 14-16 Award of Contract #14-01 Repair of Mechanical & Electrical Apparatus for 2014 to Municipal Maintenance, Inc. was presented. (See Correspondence #1)

Mr. Luthman interjected here that this contract was the subject of an email he received from Remington & Vernick Engineering. In examining the bids they found that Longo Electric listed a \$40 per hour rate which does not meet the prevailing wages standards. Therefore it is a clearly non-compliant to our criteria and was disqualified as low bid because of it.

The following constitutes T&M's Activity Report for the Pennsauken Sewerage Authority's February 18, 2014 meeting:

Sulfide Investigation

Monthly sampling and sulfide testing has been ongoing at several location within the PSA services area since January of 2011.

More recently, the focus of the study moved to the odor issues at the High Street Pump Station. T&M contacted the odor control system manufacturer who recommended a change to the carbon filter media in the unit. T&M provided the PSA with contact information for the purchase of new carbon filter media and filter media testing.

If the PSA wishes to further investigate odor issues, we recommend a review of the construction plans for the pump station in conjunction with the odor control system design guidelines to determine if the system is sized properly for the current use. To complete this task, the PSA would need to provide T&M with a copy of the construction plans for the pump station and odor control system.

During the summer of 2013, even with the hot weather that is normally associated with high sulfide levels, the PSA has received good results from the monthly sulfide testing. There have been no sulfide issues or complaints received.

System Flooding

T&M met with Thom Tillinghast of the PSA to look at areas of sanitary sewer system flooding at the intersection of Magnolia and Florida. T&M provided a proposal to the PSA for monitoring of system testing to be performed by the PSA and system improvement design.

The initial investigation requires dry weather system testing to be performed by the PSA. Once the test results are received, T&M will require authorization to proceed with services included in our pending proposal submitted on October 3, 2011.

System Improvements 48th Street and Route 130

T&M met with Thomas Tillinghast to discuss proposed system improvements near the intersection of 48th Street and Route 130. T&M prepared a proposal for professional services and construction cost estimate for the project.

To date we have not received authorization and await further direction.

Riverfront Village at Pennsauken

T&M received for review, an application for Treatment Works Approval (TWA) for the proposed Riverfront Village development located at the intersection of 47th Street and River Road. T&M has reviewed the application and found it be compliance with technical and administrative requirements of a TWA Application. T&M issued a letter recommending approval of the application on December 11, 2013.

T&M received for review, an application for Sewer Connection Application for a new residential service from the proposed Riverfront Village development. This application is being reviewed under the same PSA Account number. The application is currently under review, we anticipated the issuance of a review letter the week of February 12, 2014.

Connection Application – Puratos #2

T&M received for review, a Sewer Connection Application, for a new non-residential service from the Puratos Corporation, 8030 National Highway (Block 2105, Lot 1). The new connection will service an addition being constructed on the rear of the existing building. The following is a summary of the engineering activities for the above referenced Authority meeting:

Sycamore Ridge Sewer Application

On January 16, 2014, the PSA received an application for sewer connection by ETC Companies of Ramsey, NJ. The Applicant proposes to connect a new lateral to service a proposed clubhouse on the subject property at 3731 Herbert Avenue. The new lateral would connect to an existing Authority 8" sanitary sewer main.

A letter was issued to the applicant on January 29, 2014 addressing inconsistencies on the plans and with the calculations for wastewater flows. The proposed clubhouse wastewater flows include those of multiple uses that comprise of office space, a community room, fitness area, and laundry facilities that were not sufficiently determined in accordance with Authority standards.

We have tabulated the bids received on February 11, 2014 with reference to the above-captioned project. A copy of the tabulation is enclosed for your review.

The apparent low bidder, Longo Electrical-Mechanical, bid \$40 per hour for a mechanical helper (laborer) for work on-site where prevailing rates apply, yet bid \$80 per hour for the same labor category for work in their shop where prevailing wage rates do not apply. I suppose they anticipate that most of the work will be completed in their shop. The bid numbers are unbalanced in this regard.

The prevailing wage rates were included in the contract documents and the lowest labor rate (class A) is \$53.22 per hour. To me the \$40 per hour is an unacceptable bid rate making Longo's bid unresponsive.

The contract documents also require response within 20-minutes for emergencies, providing by-pass pumping when required. The location of Longo's facilities in Wharton, New Jersey makes it impossible for compliance.

Therefore, Municipal Maintenance Co. appears to be the lowest responsible bidder that can meet all requirements promulgated in the contract documents. Please review and advise if contracts should be awarded to both Longo Electrical-Mechanical for an amount of \$65,200.00 and Municipal Maintenance Co., for an amount of \$70,800.00, or only to Municipal Maintenance Co.

The contract documents do allow for multiply contractors. It is important to have the maintenance and repair services readily available to respond to equipment failures, to mitigate or prevent sewer system overflows effecting public well being and the environment. It is also important that contractors completing public work project in the State of New Jersey comply with wage rate requirements.

The 4" diameter sewer lateral services 2 bathrooms, with 1 lavatory and water closet in each bathroom. The applicant's engineer, BD engineering described the connection as being for 4 employees, that will use each bathroom 3 times per day, that will account for an average of 62.4 gallons per day of waste exiting the building.

The sanitary flow from the proposed restroom facilities are directed to discharge via a 4" PVC lateral that flows into an 8" PSA sewer main. The existing discharge point is located within an easement on the western property line of the site, passing through adjacent Lot 11.

Based on the information provided, the following fees apply.

Initial Application Fee:

Connection Fee:

\$ \$1,275.00 (minimum connection fee)

Escrow Fee:

\$ \$2,500.00

Performance Bond:

\$ \$6.000.00 (estimated construction cost plus 20% contingency)

Review Comments

- 1. The Application and Escrow Fees have been paid.
- 2. The applicant provided an estimate of the daily sanitary wastewater flow generated from this project of 62.4 gallons. The connection fee was determined by multiplying the projected flow (gallons/day) by \$6.37 equaling \$397.50. As the connection charge is less than minimum connection charge for a One-Family Residential Unit the minimum fee of \$1,275.00 will be assessed. Prior to issuance of a construction permit by the Authority, the Connection Fee must be paid.
- 3. The Performance Bond must be reviewed and approved by the Authority's Solicitor. Once the construction permit is issued, the Applicant shall notify T&M a minimum of 48 hours prior to initiation of the work.
- 4. This Connection Application is for the approval of non residential wastewater discharge from the manufacturing building and does not cover the discharge of process effluent. A separate Connection Application for the process effluent will be required once the final design is submitted for review.
